

Summary:

This project proposal is the continuation of the project "The Microfoundation of Economic Complexity: Theory, Behavior, Policy" (EC020í2 34928), whose staff corresponds, for the most part, with that of this project. Although its content is not exclusively experimental (also collecting the work of some members of the Department of Economics at the University of Alicante, whose research focuses *on* issues mainly of theory and applied microeconomics), many of the issues to be presented below have been developed around the activities of the Laboratory of Theoretical and Experimental Economics (LaTeX), a research center of the Department active since the year 2000.

The project is structured along three main lines of research:

1. Theory: analysis of economic networks, measures based on categories.
2. Behavior: Behavioral Finance experiments; individual and collective decisions under risk and ambiguity; individual (un)observed heterogeneity.
3. Application: Industrial organization; social pensions and political alignment; causal effect of education on health.
